Keystone First and Keystone First CHC (the "Plan") are following the guidelines outlined in the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) Medical Assistance Bulletin (MAB) 08-21-07 regarding the procedure for submitting claims for a take-home supply of naloxone.

Please bill the Plan for a take-home supply of nasal or injectable naloxone distributed to Members/Participants as follows:

- 1. Procedure code T1015 with all other applicable service codes
- 2. For reporting and tracking purposes include the recently DHS added zero-pay HCPCS code outlined below on a separate claim line:
