## **Details:**

Keystone First will follow the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) guidelines and will implement the new procedure code T1019 for reporting EVV PCS services for 15-minute units.

Effective for dates of service on or beyond May 1, 2022, EVV PCS services should be reported using T1019 as follows:

Code	Unit Type	Clock-in/Clock-out times
T1019 - Personal Care Services,	15 minutes	0 minutes – 7 minutes = 0 units
Per 15 Minutes, Not for An		8 minutes – 22 minutes = 1 unit
Inpatient Or Resident Of A		23 minutes – 37 minutes = 2 units
Hospital, Nursing Facility, ICF/MR		38 minutes – 52 minutes = 3 units
or IMD, Part Of The Individualized		53 minutes – 67 minutes = 4 units
Plan Of Treatment.		68 minutes – 82 minutes = 5 units

Effective for dates of service <u>on or before April 30, 2022 the codes below are still valid codes</u> for reporting EVV PCS:

<u>S9122</u> – Home health aide or certified nurse assistant, providing care in the home; <u>per hour</u>. <u>G0156</u> - Retired code (<u>only for reporting EVV PCS</u>). This is still a valid code for EVV home health care services (HHCS).
